

Protecting parents' rights

The Welsh dioceses along with the Catholic Education Service are running a national letter writing campaign against the Welsh Government's proposed changes to the school curriculum. These changes, if passed, will have a significantly detrimental effect on Catholic schools as well as the long-standing rights of parents. It is important that we make them know that there is widespread opposition to these proposals. The Bishops are encouraging us to promote this campaign.

Stop the Welsh Government revoking parents' rights as the primary educators of their children. It is important that sensitive subjects like Relationship and Sex Education and Religious Education are taught in accordance with parents' views.
